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### How to measure your ring size

1. Print out this document, ensuring when you are printing you do not select the option to fit to page or shrink to page.
2. Measure the outer box to ensure that it is 170 x 170 mm
3. Measure a ring that fits against the chart so that one of the outer circles matches the internal diameter of your ring.

### PLEASE NOTE.

Rings with a wider band may need to be larger, so please only use this chart as a guide, we recommend you have your finger sized by a professional jeweller.

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
